## Evaluation, comments, recommendations of the thesis advisor:

The student analyzes the successfulness of Russian securitizatized discourse over the conflict in Crimea and Donbas. She applies the most recognized branch of Securitization Theory, the one developed by the Copenhagen School, but the thesis lacks a debate of the most current literature on Securitization Theory, especially those that address the gaps in the analysis of the Copenhagen School. The text also needs some revision regarding its structure – sometimes it becomes difficult for the reader to follow some parts, and the author goes back and forth to the theory and then the analysis, even before the methodology section is explored. These are, however, only minor issues that can be easily addressed. The methodological section is exceptional. The theory was greatly applied and the analysis brings interesting findings. Based on what the author presented, the data gathered (and properly processed), I not only recommend the thesis toward defense, but I also recommended the author to make revisions and try to publish her thesis in the form of an academic article. She really did an excellent job.

I recommend – do not recommend this thesis toward bachelor thesis defense in AUGUST 2019.
